## **SPECIAL REGULATIONS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

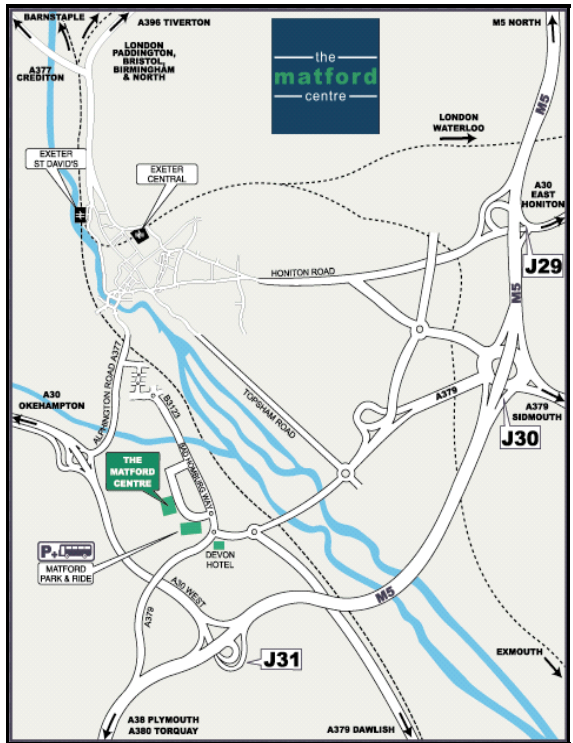
1. The Sale will be held subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Easy Care Sheep Society, the Conditions of Sale as recommended by the LAA and the Auctioneers Standard Conditions of Sale.
2. ALL SHEEP OFFERED FOR SALE MUST BE THE PROPERTY OF A CURRENT MEMBER OF THE SOCIETY AND CONFORM TO EASYCARE TYPE.
3. Entries are open to both MV and Non-MV flocks. Relevant documentation must accompany all sheep.
4. All entries must be made on official entry forms and must be completed in all respects. Entries will not be accepted if the relevant fees are omitted.
5. Substitutes are allowed. Details of any substitutes must be lodged with the Auctioneers ONE WEEK prior to the sale.
6. All sheep are warranted by vendor as correct in mouth and udder at the time of sale.
7. Vendors are responsible for taking their sheep to the sale ring and returning them to the pens after being offered for sale.
8. Sheep must have Easy Care printed on management part of the tag (easy to arrange with your tag supplier) or additional tags may be supplied by ECSS at the sale for an additional cost of 20p per tag.
9. Sheep must be hornless and have shed their fleece (no signs of clipping). Upgrading ewes will be sold at the end of the sale.
10. Vendors must provide their own straw for bedding if required (NO SAWDUST PLEASE) and feed stuffs/buckets etc.
11. All rams will be sold in guineas with a commission rate of 6%. All females will be sold in pounds with a commission rate of 5%. Commission will be split between Auctioneers and the Society.
12. All transactions, either by auction or by private treaty following the sale, must be passed through the Auctioneer's Sale Office.
13. Vendors shall have the right to place a reserve price on any, or all of their sheep. This must be notified to the Auctioneers before the commencement of that sale, and will be treated as a reserve and not a guide.
14. Ram entries are limited to a maximum of ten rams per vendor.
15. All rams offered for sale subject to an upset price which will be decided after consultation with the Auctioneer on the day of the sale.
16. Any late entries are at the discretion of the Auctioneers and will automatically be sold at the end of the sale list.
17. Anyone requiring overnight accommodation of sheep for sale please make arrangements directly with Auctioneers.

## **DIRECTIONS**

**From M5 North:** Exit Junction 30. Take third exit at the roundabout onto A379 Exeter/Marsh Barton for 3 miles. At third roundabout take last exit onto B3123 Marsh Barton/Bad Homburg Way. Exit first left at next roundabout and The Matford Centre is 200 metres on left.

**From A38 Plymouth:** Exit at A379 for 1.7 miles. Take second exit at the roundabout onto B3123 Bad Homburg Way. Exit first left at next roundabout and The Matford Centre is 200 metres on left.

**From A30 Cornwall:** Exit A377 Exeter. Follow City A377 through first road junction. Turn right, signed Marsh Barton, and follow signs to Livestock Centre.
